INFORMATION TO COMPETITORS CVI FLYINGE 2022

Dear Competitor,

We are very happy and proud to welcome you to Flyinge and our CVI 2022! With this letter, we would like to give you some practical information about the competition in order to assist you in the best possible manner.

The Crafoord Arena, where warm-up used to be, is still closed for renovation. Training and warm-up are therefore at other locations so an extra close look at the site map is recommended.

For your information is the Nordic championships in Showjumping and Dressage also taking place at Flyinge Kungsgård the days before our CVI. They will finish Thursday afternoon.

Show Office - Opening Hours

We kindly ask you to limit the number of visitors at the show office to Chef d'Equipes and club representatives. An information stand will be located outside the show office to help with other questions than direct show office questions

- Thursday 9:00-20:00 (closed during horse inspection.)
- Friday; 08.00-12:00, 13:30-21:00
- Saturday 07:30-12:00, 14:00-17:00, 18:00-19:30
- Sunday; 07:30-12:00, 13:00-17:30 (closed during price giving)

Arrival procedure

- Do not unload the horse until papers have been checked
- Documents to be checked are passport, vaccination and temperature journal, information about this according to the FEI website
- Stable the horse and pay attention to instructions from the stable crew.
- The stable passes will be given to the <u>Chef d'Equipe</u> together with the accreditations. They are collected at the show office; there will be a maximum of 3 passes per horse
- No trailers or trucks are to be parked at the stables, please see map for parking and camping area.

Stables

The stables are open

- Thursday from 8:00-22:00
- Friday-Sunday 06:00-22:00

No one except persons with valid stable pass have access to the stable area. The stable pass is individual and will be marked with a yellow sign on the accreditation badge. Breaking of this rule will be reported to the FEI.

Do not paste or glue anything to the walls or doors of the stable.

Outside the stable, there are waste containers.

Shavings and hay are for sale. No Cash! You can pay with credit card/swish at the stable. Swish (Swedish mobile pay) no 123 57 82 511

Departure procedure stable

The passport will be given back after complete cleaning of the stable you have used. Contact the stable representative and get a signed stable clean coupon. Collect your passport at the show office. No coupon no passport.

Horse inspection

Horse inspection will be indoor in the Wallenberg riding hall, starting at 16:00 on Thursday.

Walk your horse outside until the steward calls you.

After completing horse inspection, it is possible to walk your horse in the competition arena. Please follow the signs when moving from Wallenberg to the competition arena.

Declaration of starters

When you arrive on Thursday, we kindly ask you to declare your starters at the same time as you pick up your accreditation-cards.

At the horse-inspection, there will be a table where you also can do your declaration of starters or changes that might occur. <u>Deadline for this is 17.30 on Thursday</u>. All competitors (individuals, squad and pdd) have to declare their start and report start order on the horse. We need order to go on each horse and in the squads. We ask the chef d'Equipes / or club representative to come to this table to declare their starters.

On Friday there is another declaration of starters for 2* individuals and 2* pdd at 17.00 and this will be in the show-office only. This is most important for the 1* competitors that have qualified, where there also have to pay the entry fee at the same time as you make the declaration.

<u>However, please do not wait until 17.00</u>. Instead as soon as you have received your scores in the 1* competition we kindly ask you to enter the 2* immediately during the afternoon, and let us know if you are going to start in the 2* competition as quickly as possible.

Chef d'Equipe meeting

In the aula situated 50 m north of Crafoord arena at 19:00 Thursday. For the draw of 2* individual and pdd – the meeting is on Friday at 18.00 Only for Chef d'Equipes and **one** Trainer/Leader per club. Starting lists will be updated at www.cviflyinge.se

Contact Sophia upon arrival to get directions where to park your lorry/camper or where to put your tent. You will get a badge to place in your window. Any unauthorized camping will be charged with 100 Euros.

Toilets and showers are available on the camping site. Additional toilets can be found in the main arena.

<u>Training time – practice arenas</u>

There are 3 training circles inside the Wallenberg arena. Please observe that you must book your training times on Thursday at the steward in the hall. No training during horse inspection. On Thursday before horse inspection, riding is only allowed indoor in Wallenberg riding hall. After horse inspection riding is allowed on the outdoor arena, Kastanjegården. Lounging outside on the Melon paddock with 3 circles. See no 2 on site map below. On the competition day, there will also be one circle in Lilla Ridhuset and one in the main arena.

More information regarding the area will be given at the Chef d'Equipe meeting.

How to get here - Road Map

Arriving of competitors:

Directions by road: From north (E6, E4): From E6 at Landskrona take road 17 towards Eslöv. Pass Eslöv towards Gårdstånga/Lund via road 113. At Gårdstånga-junction towards Sjöbo via road 104. After 4 km you reach Flyinge. Turn right in little roundabout. Flyinge Kungsgård/Arena 1 km. Welcome! From South (E6/E20): Take E22 towards Lund. Pass Lund. 10 km past Lund turn left towards Sjöbo at Gårdstånga-junction. After 4 km you reach Flyinge. Turn right in little roundabout. Flyinge Kungsgård/Arena 1 km.

When arriving with horses:

Follow the motorway E22 northbound of Lund in the direction of Kalmar. Take the first exit after Lund north called Gårdsstånga with the sign Sjöbo, Kävlinge 104. Take the first exit in the roundabout marked Flyinge, Sjöbo. Follow the road and take the next exit to the right marked Gårdsstånga, ESS 6. Take the next exit to the left marked S Sandby 5. Follow the road until the sign Flyingeby 2, Seminstation to the left. Follow the road straight on to the sign Flyinge Kungsgård, Ehrengranats allé. Carry on towards Flyinge Kungsgård in the alley and you come to the arrival place for the horses.
